Speaker: Mike Shannon

Michael Shannon is a Professor of Congregational Ministry for Johnson University and is program director of their Indiana and Kentucky projects. Mike is a third-generation preacher in the Christian churches. He holds degrees from Milligan College, Kentucky Christian College, Cincinnati Bible Seminary, and received the Doctor of Ministry degree from Reformed Theological Seminary.

Shannon has held preaching ministries and church planting ministries in Tennessee, Florida, Ohio, and Kentucky. He taught at Cincinnati Christian University for over 20 years. Mike is the author or co-author of seven books for ministers and the Bible study book, Lighten Up. He is a regular contributor to Preaching Magazine and a frequent contributor to Lookout, Christian Standard, Devotion, and the Standard Lesson Commentary.

His interests include visiting presidential historical sites, collecting Dr. Pepper memorabilia, ventriloquism, and The Andy Griffith Show.
